

1. WHAT IS AN ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY?

- 1.1. An Acceptable Use Policy (“**AUP**”) is a policy which sets out the rules applicable to the use of fibertime™’s services. Most of these relate to legal requirements, but we also need to ensure that our network and customers are kept safe and secure.

2. AGREEMENT TO THIS AUP

- 2.1. You agree that you will only use fibertime™’s services in a manner consistent with this AUP and that your failure to do so may be grounds for fibertime™ to suspend or discontinue service provision.

3. UNACCEPTABLE USE

- 3.1. Any criminal, illegal or unlawful act.
- 3.2. Any use which intentionally interferes with fibertime™’s ability to provide our services in any respect.
- 3.3. Any use which intentionally interferes with fibertime™’s rights or the rights of any third party.
- 3.4. Any use which is a breach of any other agreement fibertime™ may have entered into with you or any policy or other terms and conditions which you have agreed to in connection with the use of our services.
- 3.5. The use of the service to send unsolicited direct marketing communications in contravention of applicable law or which would cause us to be in contravention of the Internet Service Providers’ Association Code of Conduct.
